

Newsletter - Friday 6th October 2023

It's been a fairly quiet and steady week this week at Shawlands, with Miss Hartley's Y5 class visiting Horizon to take part in a skipping festival on Wednesday, and a team of Y5 and Y6s off to the Reds in the Community today for a Tag Rugby event. Other than that, the children have been hard at work in the classroom, with lots of children from different year groups visiting my room throughout the week to show me some very impressive pieces of writing from descriptions of new villains for Supertato to battle, to first-hand accounts of trench warfare.

Next week in contrast will be a really busy one, with our first SEND week of the year, a girls football match against Holy Rood and a Y5 Lacrosse event at Reds! We are also holding a Phonics Parents meeting on Thursday from 2.30pm where Y1 parents can find out about how they can help their child progress in phonics, and prepare for the Phonics Screening Check in June next year.

Attendance

Over the last few newsletters, we've been highlighting the importance of good attendance and punctuality, so I thought this week I'd share some attendance data comparing attendance in each year group this year compared with the same period last year. Every year group has higher attendance than last year, with Y2 and Y3 up by 0.4%, Y4 up by 0.9%, Y5 and Y6 up by 2.7% and Y1 up by an amazing 3.3%. Our target as a school is 97%, above the national attendance figure, which last year was 94%. Last year our attendance was 94%, but this year, so far, we are on 95.5% (compared to 94.2% last year). Obviously, we would still ask that where children are not well enough to attend school they are kept at home, and we are always available to talk about any other issues which might be affecting attendance, but we would like to say a big thank you for helping us continue to keep moving attendance back to pre-Covid levels.

Halloween Disco – 26th October

On Thursday the 26th October (our last day of term) we will be holding a Halloween disco in school for all children. Children can come to school in their costumes (if they wish) and will have a disco during the school day. We will send more information out about this event next week but wanted to give parents advance warning in case they wanted to start making or buying any costumes. Children do not have to come to school in costume and can wear non uniform that day instead.

Friday 27th October is an inset day and children will be back in school on Monday 6th November.
