What is Phonics?

- Phonics is the way we teach children to read in school.
- We follow the Read Write Inc phonics scheme and have been working really hard on embedding this.

- Children begin learning letters and then sounds (digraphs and trigraphs/'special friends') and then use this knowledge to read and spell words.

What is the Phonics Screening Check?

- All children in Year 1 throughout the country will take part in the check during the same week in June
- The check is to confirm whether individual children have learnt phonics to an appropriate standard
- This year the check will take place in the week commencing 10th June



What happens during the check?

- The test contains 40 words 20 real words and **20 'alien'** words
- In the last few years the **pass mark** has been **32**, although it is not guaranteed to stay the same
- Children will sit, one at a time, and read each word aloud to a familiar adult

What are alien words?

- Were created to test children's phonics knowledge and ensure they aren't learning words by sight alone
- Will include digraphs the children are familiar with from phonics lessons
- Make sure children don't try and make these make sense – "what a lot of nonsense!"





Reporting to parents

- We will let you know your child's score on their end of year report
- If your child has not yet passed do not worry! They will retake the test when they are in Year 2.





How can I help my child at home?

- READ!!! Regular reading as much as possible
- This can be their phonics book, their eBook and phonics quiz on Oxford Owl as well as any other appropriate books.
- Help them to sound out unknown words using the sounds we learn in phonics (see website and sound cards already send home)
- Encourage "special friends, Fred-talk, read the word" for any unfamiliar words
- Make sure you are using 'pure sounds'. Not 'tuh' and 'suh'.

- Blend the sounds in a word by pointing to each one, e.g. /c/ in cat, /p/ in pat, /ng/ in sing, /ee/ in been. Next move your finger under the whole word as you say it
- Discuss the meaning of a word if your child does not know what they have read
