### Notification of school meal price increase

We would like to give you notice that as of Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2024 school meal charges will increase to £2.65, this is due to an increase in price from our provider. We currently subsidise a school meal by 10p per paid meal and will continue to subsidise this until the end of the school year 19<sup>th</sup> July, unfortunately due to our very restricted budget we cannot continue to do this in September, therefore we regrettably have to increase the price to £2.75 in line with our charge from school catering.
