

## Newsletter – Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March

You probably won't have missed the coverage on the news this week about the increased drive on attendance coming from the government via the DfE which requires schools to be making every effort to 'drive up' attendance for all children. We recognise this is an emotive subject, with parents being the people best placed to decide when children need to be off school for illness, and also with the increased costs of holidays during the school holidays.

Following our letters out in December, we saw a 2% rise in attendance, and this has been followed up by further letters and some home visits by the Education Welfare Service. Having consulted with governors this week, it is very likely that we will be issuing our first Fixed Penalty Notices for term-time holidays for some time. As you will probably know, at the moment these fines are £60 per child, per parent, per week, but in September this will be increasing to £80.
