Dear Parents/Carers



School Dinner Money

Please could all parent's pay off their children's school lunch money. There is a lot of outstanding balances which need paying immediately.

Medication and care plans

All medication will be returned home with children today with a new medical form. Walking home from school

If your child is in year 5 or 6 and you would like them to walk home from school on their own please give consent on gateway before returning. This is open now and will remain open until the 31st of August. If consent is not given before then all children will need collecting.

If your child is in years 3 and 4 and you would like them to walk to the gate please also give consent on gateway. When signing this be aware that we try to have a member of staff on the gate each evening but this is not always possible. By giving consent you must be confident that your child will return to school if for any reason you are not there to collect.

Please note that if school closes early for any reason, e.g.snow or other events, all children must be collected by an adult and will not be able to walk home alone.
