


Very Impressive Pupil





This girl always in with a smile on her face ready for the day. She always tries her best and always gets involved during class discussions, even when she's unsure. Keep being a star!







Mia is such an excellent role model for Year 3. She is always ready to learn, listens carefully and produces work of a high standard. She is an absolute star and a pleasure to teach.




